

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS, LICENSES, PERMITS

Vendor Licensing as well as any copies of any permits and licenses applicable to the sale of their products will be required. Vendors are responsible for complying with State and local licensing requirements governing the production and sales of their products. Failure at any time to conform to local, State or Federal requirements can be grounds for removal from the market and forfeiture of space fees. - Re-admission plan after receiving a passing score apply to Market Manager for readmission.
- Cider Warning Label "This product has not been pasteurized and therefore may contain harmful bacteria that can cause serious illness in children, the elderly, and persons with weakened immune systems".
- Vendors advertising organic products must display their Organic Certificate in booth at all times.
